I am the respondent in above-entitled Family court matter, (Robert A. Gibbs). I am writing to request that my daughter, Forest H. Gibbs be brought to the Jail for an extended visit with me, her father beginning as soon as humanly possible and for continuing visits every week for as long as I am at the Jail for Forest's psychological well-being. Despite numerous requests through third parties to petitioner Cheri A. Dubuque to facilitate visits with Forest, after three months the child has not been brought one single time - not only do I believe that this inaction by the mother speaks volumes about her inability to truly care about the needs of this child, I believe Cheri is willfully and actually abusing this child by denying access to this father. Cheri's immaturity precludes her from realizing that it was because of our family, and primarily Forest's rights to have a natural, nurturing family (her own and not some substitute) that I ultimately ended up horribly entangled with an oblivious and un-caring court. Cheri's immaturity precludes her from understanding that as one of my few acquaintances and as the mother of my child that instead of abandoning me (and Forest) in our time of need Cheri should be fighting very hard for my right to be free to care for Forest. Someone should explain to Cheri the concept "in for a penny, in for a pound". Does she think it is good for a two year old girl to think her father is dead?? I have said before that Cheri's immaturity precludes her from understanding the absolute necessity of a stable, loving relationship between Forest and I irregardless of circumstance. I believe Cheri's actions since my arrest (and before) prove this out.
